



CASE STUDY...

WOOLTON VETERINARY CENTRE

Woolton Veterinary Centre, Liverpool

Woolton Vets are an independent, family run veterinary practice, who, when we met the team, were seeking to improve their existing facility by expanding into and converting the house next door - that they also happened to live in!

Alex and Sarah McVey, owners of the practice, always had the potential of expansion in the back of their mind, and contacted us when the time was right to help them achieve their goal. Already well established in the local community, the vets did not want to stop their vital services during the project, and therefore remained open throughout.

Their existing practice and the residential property next door, were both Grade II listed buildings, and located within the Woolton Village Conservation area. From the onset, we knew that the project would be steered by strict planning constraints, which involved frequent discussions with the Local Heritage Authority.

Whereas planning officers are not usually concerned with the details of minor alterations to a property, a conservation area comes with numerous constraints. In Woolton Vets' case, this included not being able to use solar panels, only having a choice of two colours for the front door, and preserving the existing window detail, which we achieved by improving the timber double glazing with Georgian bars.





espite the strict planning regulations, the vets had a charming set of two buildings - the stone of which was taken from a large quarry that also supplied the stone for Liverpool cathedral - with enormous potential for an improved space.

The only potential barrier we identified within the residential property was the low ceiling heights in the basement, meaning that the vets could not expand their clinical area into it. Thankfully, this was overcome by working closely with the vets to design a new layout, where the clinicial space was relocated to the first floor, retaining client facing areas on the ground floor and moving animal wards and staff suites to the basement. We also included a bespoke platform lift into the design so that this would be achievable.

As the construction works, which were phased to prevent disruption in the clinic, grew closer to completion, potential setbacks with the existing service were uncovered. This included rotten joists to the rear roof and faults with the foul water drainage system.

Although converting residential is not for the faint hearted, we had the right tools and experience to get the project over the line. With our direction, the contractors were able to repair these problems on site without creating delays, or causing the practice to close at any stage.

Despite these hurdles, which included the COVID-19 pandemic complicating and delaying building works, Woolton Vets have been happily and successfully operating out of their expanded practice since October of 2022. ACD are thrilled for the team, patients and clients who will experience the benefits of this fantastic practice for a long time to come.





CASE STUDY...

Aldgate Veterinary Practice, Bridlington

Aldgate Veterinary Practice had big aspirations to build and design a fit for purpose veterinary practice to serve the community. The uniquely triangular/pentagonal shaped building, designed by separate architects, sits on a junction and is intended to follow the pattern of the road. ACD Projects became involved as the vets needed a firm on board who really understood veterinary, and could design the fit-out of their striking facility.

Lucy Butler, one of the directors of Aldgate Vets, had seen from her very first shift at the Bridlington Branch, that the local area was crying out for improved veterinary facilities. Together with the rest of the team, she envisioned a new referral facility that would provide additional and exceptional services, including Hydrotherapy, state-of-the-art Imaging, Dental Care and Orthopaedic Surgery, all of which we catered for within the final design.









Having a particularly large team (of circa 80!) staff wellbeing was at the forefront of Aldgate's design. Careful attention was therefore made to ensure the vets are always in an inspiring and safe environment. For example, a central hub was introduced to prevent any staff member feeling isolated, natural light is present wherever possible, and homely overnight facilities were designed to accommodate the dedicated night team.

Additionally, the vets wanted their clients to feel welcome, comfortable and in safe hands from the moment they walked through the entrance doors. To guarantee this client experience, we assisted the vets in the design of a dedicated room for answering client calls and queries. This ensured that the vets' clients and patients have full attention and care of the reception team, and urgent phone calls are dealt with straight away.

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ppointed as Project Managers to oversee the construction works, we met certain challenges due to the shape of the building. For example, a metal structure had been used to support the curved roof in the original build. Due to this, issues were uncovered with air and water tightness between joints within this structure. We overcame this with the contractors by fire-stopping all of the roof eaves, and sealing them with plasterboard.



"As the only independent vets in Driffield and Bridlington, we really wanted our new practice to stand out and provide exceptional services to the community. That is why it was important for us to work with a team who had understanding and experience in veterinary design, and ACD were certainly unmatched in this area.

ACD listened to our brief closely and helped turn our vision into a reality, their multidisciplinary way of working was really useuful as it meant they were on board from start to finish for our internal design and project management. The consistency was key to the success of the project, and it was reassuring that pur project manager knew our practice inside out.

As with a lot of developments, we encountered some unforeseen issues along the way, however ACD worked closely with us, our shell architects and our contractors to navigate through the challenges we faced. In addition, one of the most crucial aspects of Mechanical & Electrical servicing of a veterinary project is adequate ventilation. Due to planning limitations when it came to altering the building elevations, the vets had a restricted number of openings/grills allowed through the external walls to ventilate the practice. As the material used in the construction of the roof was so delicate, we knew that ventilation could not go through in this manner either, and so had to create bigger ducts and form localised large openings in specific areas of the building to overcome the obstacles.

Now, we are pleased to say that the vets, their clients, and patients are all still enjoying their wonderful new practice, which is a building that reflects the welcoming and caring team who run the show!
